

## Academic VPs Administer Oral Verification Test



For three consecutive days, seven vice-principals from the different departments of PSD, headed by Dr. Cleofe Macaraeg-Pascual, the Vice Principal of the Primary Department, joined forces in administering the Oral Verification Test to all the 377 grade one students of Philippine School Doha. This was a move coined by Dr. Alexander S. Acosta, the school principal, as part of the school's quest to provide its learners a lifelong learning. It aimed to find out the reading readiness of all students in the level as well as their ability to answer simple comprehension questions. Moreover, it was undertaken to identify students with reading difficulties, to design necessary plans of intervention and to formulate

ways to establish and sustain their interest for reading. The activity was conducted last October 30 to November 1, 2018.
